- f. Be friendly, courteous, and enthusiastic whether winning or losing_____
- g. Cooperate with coaches and squad at all times_____
- h. No use of foul, crude or abusive language or obscene gestures will be tolerated_____
- i. Dress modestly to all practices: full cut t-shirt tucked in, athletic shorts, competition shoes, NO tank tops allowed. Hair must be pulled back, no jewelry of any kind._____
- j. Consistent violations of any of the above may result in expulsion from the squad_____

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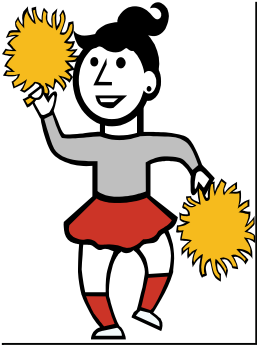

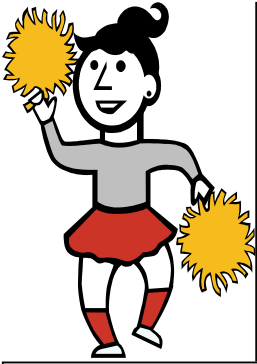
Extra practices are scheduled as needed by the squad's coach and are mandatory.
